Quiet Time After 10.30pm - This Must Be Adhered to by all campers. After 10.30pm no **music** is to be played, and we ask everyone to return to their own units or tents. We ask you to be mindful and respectful to your fellow campers. No sound systems or noise from devices allowed at all after this time - complete silence after 12pm - we are a family campsite.

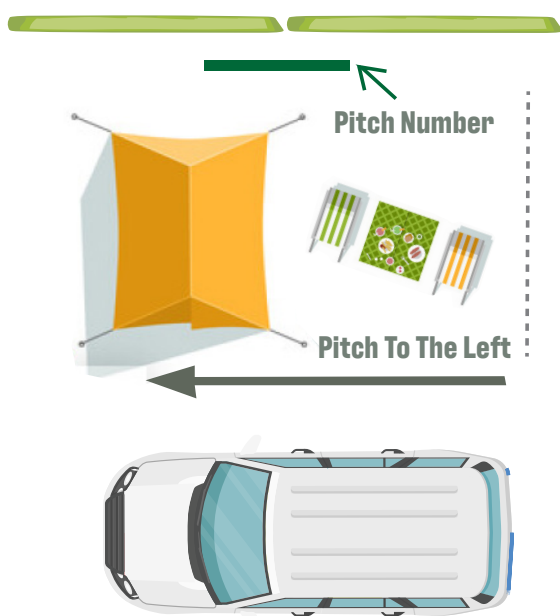
Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times around site including the amenity blocks, bistro and barn. **Antisocial behavior** will not be **tolerated**, we issue a two warning policy, if you receive more than two warnings then you will be asked to leave immediately.



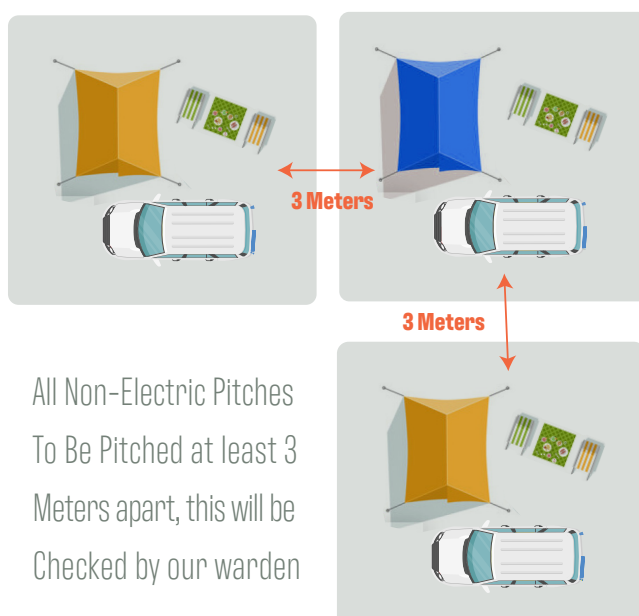
If you are in a group of **three tents** or more & want to pitch together we do require a good behavior bond of **£50.00 per tent** which is refundable on departure. This bond is taken to ensure that all groups abide by the campsite rules, to ensure that everyone staying with us has an enjoyable stay.

HELP ON HOW TO PITCH UP

ELECTRIC PITCH



NON-ELECTRIC PITCH



Maximum tent size 5M wide a 4-6 man tent. If on an electric pitch you tent must comfortably fit within the pitch, your car must be able to be parked at the front of your pitch, within the pitch markings. **Maximum Gazebo Size: 3x3m**



Vehicles: In busy periods all extra vehicles will be required to park in a designated overflow parking area. One vehicle parked next to pitch only.



Electric pitches: Electric hook ups have a low voltage supply, please do not use household appliances. A fine of £50 will apply for using splitters on electric hook ups. Electric car charging not permitted from your pitch.



RECYCLING: Recycling law applies to all business in Wales. What To Recycle: Food - **Paper & Card - Glass - Metal, Plastic & Cartons**

If You Can't Fit It In The Bins Provided (Its To Large) Please Take It Home With You.

Fines of £300-£500 will apply for breaking the law and you will be reported to local authorities.
